Machining the lower will take some time as the Florida heat is still pretty oppressive during the hours when the neighbors won't object too strenuously to the sound of a router milling aluminum. This is a drawback to completing this project from an 80% lower; however, the 80% lower has it's advantages as well. Of course, I could have purchased a complete lower and processed it through an FFL and been well on my way to a completed rifle, but I probably would not have been able to come in at or under \$1000.

Once the rifle is built, a new challenge will need to be overcome. There are no public 1000 yard ranges anywhere near the west-central Florida area. Since the 1000 yard range is no longer operational at the Manatee Gun & Archery Club in Myakka, FL, I may have to make the 6.5 hour road trip to the Altus range in Baker, FL. Perhaps a trip out west to any of the wide open spaces out there will be in order... provided of course travel is still permitted. Stay tuned for more videos and updates on this project, including testing and sighting in the rifle.
